ACO Nest Box

Shelter for birds that can be built into new or existing walls.

Designed to provide a sheltered nesting refuge for or small wild birds like blue tits or sparrows.

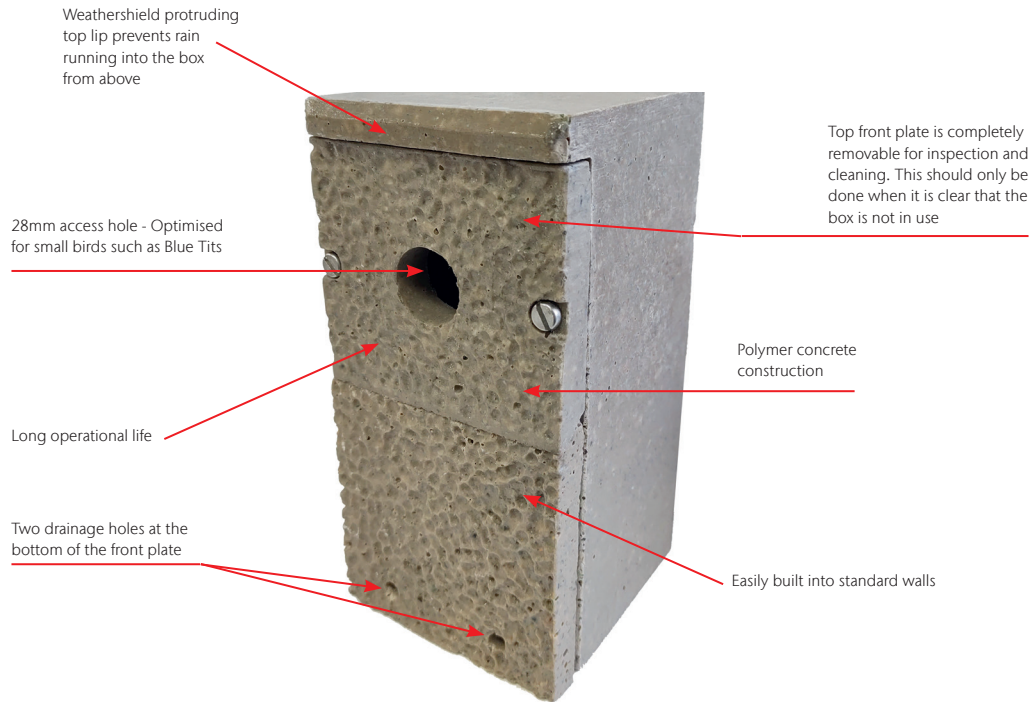
The box is three standard brick courses high and half a brick course in width, so is easy to build in to a wall during construction. Alternatively the box may be retrospectively built in, by cutting out a suitable area, or it can be fixed to the face of an existing wall.

Benefits

- Manufactured from polymer concrete, the ACO Nest Box is immune to the freeze/thaw process with a water absorption rate of only 0.05%.
- The front of the box is fitted flush to the wall, with only a small lip at the top protruding. This acts as a weathershield to prevent water entering from above.

ACO Nest Box Installation

STEP 1

The ACO Nest Box should be installed during the bricklaying process ensuring that the front of the box is flush to the front face of the wall. When installing, attention should be paid to the front plate to allow for a suitable gap to remove it for inspection and cleaning.

STEP 2

The ACO Nest Box should be installed into the brick face at least 1.5m above the ground and away from direct sunlight, preferably near to trees and bushes.

STEP 3

The ACO Nest Box can be retrofitted to existing buildings by cutting a hole into the chosen wall. This can be done by marking the wall with the required dimensions, cutting the perimeter of the marked area using a suitable saw, fitted with a masonry blade, and chiselling out the loose brickwork.

STEP 4

If required the Nest Box can be painted on site. Wipe with a solvent remover, prime, and for best results use masonry paint.
